HEAL Clinical Trial Exam

The trial exam is a simulation of the Australian Medical Council part 2 clinical examination. International Medical Graduates (IMGs) participate in a 4 hour trial exam consisting of 16 Objective Clinical Structured Examination (OSCE) stations.



As a role player you:

- Attend full day at the exam 7.30am–5.30pm.
- Learn the role of the patient in 2 cases that are provided to you or 1 case if single exam session.
- Opportunity to liaise with specialist medical staff.
- Receive an honorarium of \$100 cash (full day) or \$75 cash for single exam session and a letter of participation.
- Will have food provided to you throughout the day.

Trial exam format

- Candidates have:
 - 2 minutes reading time
 - 8 minutes to perform tasks
 - 2 minutes verbal feedback from the examiner
- The role player is only required to play the patient and isn't involved with feedback
